Day 01 | 17 July | Delhi to Kathmandu

- Gathering at Delhi Airport, Welcome session: basic tour briefing and group introduction.
- Flight from Delhi to Kathmandu , Arrival and hotel check-in.
- Evening at leisure for rest and preparation.
- **Dinner:** At hotel, buffet.
- **Stay:** Kathmandu.
- **Selected Hotels:** Hotel Crystal Pashupatinath / Jiu Ding Joy Hotel / Woodapple Hotel & Spa / Hotel Marshyangdi / Hotel Lo Mustang / Hotel Thrive, A Tropical Courtyard / Hotel Ambassador by ACE Hotels.

Day 02 | 18 July | Kathmandu Darshan

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Morning visit to Pashupatinath Temple for Darshan.
- Visit Budhanilkantha Temple, also known as Sleeping Vishnu.
- Visit Boudhanath Stupa, one of Kathmandu's most peaceful spiritual landmarks.
- Documentation / Yatra briefing assistance, if required as per permit process.
- **Dinner:** At hotel, buffet. | **Stay:** Kathmandu, same hotel.



Day 03 | 19 July | Kathmandu to Janakpur

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Drive from Kathmandu to Janakpur, approximately 225 km / 6 to 7 hours.
- Lunch en route at a hygienic restaurant or arranged by our catering team with the group, depending on route and timing.
- Visit Ram Janaki Temple, the sacred birthplace of Mata Sita.
- **Dinner:** At hotel, buffet.
- **Stay:** Janakpur.
- **Selected Hotels:** Hotel Mithila Yatri Niwas / Hotel Janaki Star, or similar.
- **Important Note:** There will be no return to Kathmandu on this day. A comfortable overnight stay is arranged in Janakpur.

Day 04 | 20 July | Janakpur to Pokhara

- Early morning start from Janakpur to Pokhara, approximately 365 km / 8 to 10 hours.
- Breakfast will be provided as a food packet with snacks and fruits, or at a local restaurant en route, depending on actual weather, timing and road condition.
- Lunch en route at a hygienic restaurant or arranged by our catering team with the group.
- Arrival at Pokhara and hotel check-in.
- **Dinner:** At hotel.
- **Stay:** Pokhara.
- **Selected Hotels:** Temple Himalaya Hotel & Spa / Hotel Landmark / Pokhara Alpine & Springs / Hotel White Pearl / Hotel Pokhara Grande, or similar.





Day 05 | 21 July | Pokhara - Jomsom - Muktinath - Kagbeni / Jomsom

- Early morning transfer to Pokhara Airport.
- Mountain flight from Pokhara to Jomsom, approximately 20 to 25 minutes, subject to weather clearance.
- Breakfast will be provided as a food packet with snacks and fruits, or at hotel / local restaurant depending on weather and flight timing.
- Upon arrival at Jomsom, drive to Muktinath Temple for Darshan.
- Visit / proceed towards Kagbeni as per timing and local conditions.
- Kagbeni is an ancient Hindu pilgrimage place, revered as a sacred Pitrumoksha Sthal for Pind Daan and Tarpan Vidhi for ancestors.
- **Dinner:** At hotel / lodge.
- **Stay:** Kagbeni / Jomsom.
- Selected Hotels: Hotel Bob Marley / Hotel de Purang / Hotel Dragon / Mustang Gateway Kagbeni / Hotel Om's / Lo Mustang Himalayan Resort, or similar.
- Important Note: Jomsom flights are fully weather dependent. If the flight is cancelled due to weather or operational reasons, alternative transfer by road will be arranged as per situation, safety and operational feasibility. The team will manage arrangements with practical care.

Day 06 | 22 July | Jomsom to Pokhara

- Early morning transfer to Jomsom Airport.
- Mountain flight from Jomsom to Pokhara, subject to weather clearance.
- Breakfast will be provided as a food packet with snacks and fruits, or at hotel / local restaurant depending on weather and flight timing.
- Visit Gupteshwar Mahadev Cave and Pumdikot Shiva Temple / Shiva Statue, subject to time and conditions.
- Dinner: At hotel.
- Stay: Pokhara, same hotel.



Day 07 | 23 July | Pokhara to Timure

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Drive from Pokhara to Timure, approximately 250 km / 8 to 10 hours.
- Scenic mountain drive through the Kathmandu highway sector.
- **Dinner:** At guest house.
- **Stay:** Timure.
- **Selected Hotels / Guest Houses:** Norling Hotel / Hotel Kailash / Hotel Yanghila, or similar.

Day 08 | 24 July | Timure - Rasuwagadhi Border - Gyirong, Tibet

- Breakfast at hotel / guest house.
- Drive from Timure to Rasuwagadhi Border, approximately 15 km / 30 to 40 minutes.
- Complete Nepal immigration formalities.
- Walk across the Friendship Bridge and complete China immigration formalities.
- Drive from Rasuwagadhi Border to Gyirong Town, approximately 24 km / 1 hour.
- Arrival and hotel check-in.
- **Stay:** Gyirong, Tibet.
- **Selected Hotels:** Yunrui Hotel / Vienna Hotel / Jilong Dayi Hotel / Ri Wu Ban Ba Royal Hotel / Yuntian Intercontinental / Days Inn Hotel, or similar.
- **Meal Note:** During the Tibet journey, fresh vegetarian meals will be prepared by our dedicated catering team. Trek meals and meal timings will be managed as per actual route schedule, health, weather and local conditions.

Day 09 | 25 July | Rest & Acclimatization at Gyirong

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Full day reserved for rest and proper acclimatization to high altitude.
- Short optional walk and local exploration in Gyirong town, depending on health and weather conditions.
- Oximeter monitoring / basic health observation as per team guidance.
- **Dinner:** At hotel.
- **Stay:** Gyirong, same hotel.

Day 10 | 26 July | Gyirong to Saga

- Breakfast as per schedule.
- Drive from Gyirong to Saga, approximately 230 to 240 km / 5 to 6 hours.
- Enjoy the beautiful drive through the dramatic high-altitude landscape of Tibet.
- Arrival and hotel check-in.
- **Dinner:** At hotel.
- **Stay:** Saga, Tibet.
- **Selected Hotels:** Norling Hotel / Hotel Vienna / Orange Rich Oxygen Hotel / Urban Garden International / Holiday Inn Saga / Saga Champions Hotel, or similar.

Day 11 | 27 July | Saga to Lake Mansarovar

- Breakfast as per schedule.
- Drive from Saga to Holy Lake Mansarovar, approximately 450 km / 8 to 10 hours.
- First Darshan of Mount Kailash from the Mansarovar region, subject to weather and visibility
- Mansarovar Half Parikrama by authorized / conservation vehicle, subject to local regulations.
- Arrival and guest house check-in.
- **Stay:** Near Mansarovar..

Day 12 | 28 July | Mansarovar - Purnima Tithi Puja - Darchen

- **Breakfast:** At hotel (Buffet). Morning / forenoon visit to the Lake Mansarovar side, subject to weather and local permission.
- Holy Snan and group Puja arrangements at Mansarovar, subject to health, weather, Panchang timing and local authority permission.
- The sacred Purnima Tithi / Guru Purnima period is observed with devotion and discipline as per practical conditions at Mansarovar.
- Visit Chiu Gompa / Chiu Monastery, subject to permission, time and road condition.
- Drive from Mansarovar to Darchen, the base town for Kailash Parikrama.
- Arrival and guest house check-in.
- **Stay:** Darchen Guest House.

Day 13 | 29 July | Guru Purnima - Kailash Parikrama Day 01

- **Breakfast:** Food Packet (snacks & fruits). Divine morning in the sacred Kailash region on Guru Purnima.
- Drive from Darchen to Yamdwar, Kailash Parikrama / Kora begins from Yamdwar.
- Trek from Yamdwar to Dirapuk, approximately 12 km.
- Darshan of the North Face of Mount Kailash, subject to weather and visibility.
- **Stay:** Dirapuk Guest House.
- **Important Note:** During the Kailash Parikrama, accommodation and facilities are very basic due to the remote high-altitude region. Meal timings, trek movement and stay arrangements will be managed according to weather, health and ground conditions.



Day 14 | 30 July | Kailash Parikrama Day 02

- Early morning trek towards Dolma La Pass, the highest point of the Yatra.
- Darshan of Gaurikund from the route, subject to weather and physical feasibility.
- Continue trek towards Zuthulpuk, approximately 18 to 20 km total trek for the day.
- Stay: Zuthulpuk Guest House.

Day 15 | 31 July | Kailash Parikrama Day 03

- Short morning trek passing sacred Mani walls.
- Completion of Kailash Parikrama near Darchen.
- Drive from Darchen to Saga.
- **Stay:** Saga, same / similar hotel.

Day 16 | 01 August | Saga to Gyirong

- Breakfast as per schedule.
- Drive from Saga to Gyirong, approximately 230 km / 5 to 6 hours.
- Scenic drive through the high-altitude Tibetan landscape, including the Pelku Lake region, subject to route condition.
- Arrival and hotel check-in.
- **Stay:** Gyirong.

Day 17 | 02 August | Gyirong - Nepal Border - Kathmandu

- Drive from Gyirong to Rasuwagadhi Border.
- Complete China immigration formalities.
- Cross the border and complete Nepal immigration formalities.
- Drive to Kathmandu.
- **Stay:** Kathmandu.
- **Tibet Meal Note:** Trek meals and fresh vegetarian meals during the Tibet journey will be served according to actual schedule, health, weather and operational conditions.

Day 18 | 03 August | Kathmandu to Delhi

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Transfer to Kathmandu Airport.
- Return flight from Kathmandu to Delhi.
- Yatra concludes with the divine blessings of Lord Shiva, Lake Mansarovar and Mount Kailash.

Operational Flexibility & Safety Provision

- Kailash Mansarovar Yatra is a high-altitude Himalayan Yatra and is fully subject to weather conditions, flight operations, road conditions, health conditions, immigration formalities, border movement, permit approvals and local authority permissions in Nepal and Tibet region.
- **Operational flexibility is internally reserved in this Yatra to manage:**
 - Possible Pokhara - Jomsom flight delay or cancellation.
 - Weather-related travel adjustments.
 - Route, road, landslide, border or local authority changes.
 - Kailash Charan Sparsh opportunity, only if officially permitted, medically safe and operationally possible.
 - Health, rest or acclimatization requirements of the group.
- The planned return from Kathmandu is 03 August. However, yatris are strongly advised to keep their return schedule flexible till 04 August, if required due to operational, weather, health or spiritual reasons.
- The Organizer reserves the right to modify the itinerary sequence in the larger interest of safety, weather conditions, local rules and smooth completion of the Yatra.
- Kailash Yatra demands patience, discipline, flexibility and spiritual surrender.

DIVINE YATRA CONTRIBUTION

Double Sharing: ₹3,25,000 per person

- **Room Basis:** Twin / Double Sharing, This is the standard adult package price for yatris travelling on double sharing room basis.

Single Occupancy: ₹3,80,000

- **Age:** 7 to 11.99 Years
- **Room Basis:** Private single occupancy room
- Applicable for yatris who prefer not to share room with another traveller.
- **Note:** Single occupancy is subject to hotel availability and applies only where private rooms are operationally available. Remote guest houses / dormitory sectors such as Mansarovar, Dirapuk and Zuthulpuk are normally on group sharing basis as per local conditions.

International & Domestic Travel

- International return flight: Delhi - Kathmandu - Delhi.
- 10 kg pre-paid additional baggage allowance on return flight, as per airline policy.
- Pokhara - Jomsom - Pokhara mountain flight, subject to weather and operational conditions.
- All airport transfers in Nepal by tourist vehicle as per group size.
- All ground transportation in Nepal as per itinerary by SUV / tourist vehicle / luxury bus, depending on group size and route condition.
- Border transfers: Timure - Rasuwagadhi - Gyirong - return sector, as per itinerary.
- Ground transportation in Tibet region by comfortable tourist vehicle according to group size and local authority regulations.
- Toyota Land Cruiser / 4x4 vehicle support in high-altitude sectors wherever operationally required and permitted.

- China Group Visa processing through the Chinese Embassy, as per applicable procedure.
- Assistance for necessary documentation, permit process and border formalities.
- Government taxes and service charges applicable to included services.

Yatra Management & Support

- Organizer personally accompanying the group throughout the Yatra.
- Dedicated Tour Manager / support coordination for approximately every 20 Yatris, subject to final group size and operational arrangement.
- Government Registered, Authorized and experienced local support team from Nepal and Tibet region.
- English-speaking Tibetan local guide in Tibet.
- Cook, support staff, necessary crew and Nepalese group escort during the journey.
- Full assistance during immigration, permit process and border crossing.

PACKAGE INCLUSIONS CONTINUE & EXCLUSIONS

Safety & Medical Support

- Big oxygen cylinders in vehicle for emergency support.
- Oximeter monitoring during high-altitude stay.
- Basic first-aid support with the team.
- Coordination support for medical emergency, if required.

Mandatory Insurance Requirement

- Travel & Rescue Insurance is mandatory for all Yatris.
- Insurance must include high-altitude evacuation and medical emergency coverage.
- Unless specifically included in written confirmation, insurance cost is not included in the package and must be arranged by the Yatri.

Package Exclusions

- Personal pony, horse or porter charges during Kailash Parikrama.
- Personal pooja, special rituals, private priest charges, donations or special offerings.
- Travel & Rescue Insurance, unless specifically included in written confirmation.
- Lunch in Kathmandu, except where specifically mentioned.
- Personal expenses such as laundry, internet, bottled drinks, snacks, room service, tips, shopping, etc.
- Extra hotel stay, additional meals, transport or any cost arising due to flight cancellation, weather disturbance, landslide, border closure, political issue, health issue or force majeure conditions.
- Excess baggage charges beyond airline allowance.
- Any cost arising due to change in government rules, permit fee increase, visa fee change, currency fluctuation or local authority requirement.
- Medical treatment, hospitalisation, evacuation or rescue cost beyond basic coordination support.
- Any service not specifically mentioned under Package Inclusions.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION POLICY

Kailash Mansarovar Yatra involves advance payments for flights, hotels, Tibet permits, visa processing, local operators and high-altitude logistics. Therefore, booking and cancellation terms are strict.

Limited Group Size & Confirmation Policy

To maintain discipline, safety and personal attention during the Yatra:

1. Group size will be strictly limited.
2. Confirmation will be given on a first-come, first-confirmed basis.
3. Seat will be considered confirmed only after receipt of the required booking amount, documents and written confirmation from Yattralay.
4. Passport details, photographs, medical information and required documents must be submitted within the timeline shared by the company.

Early confirmation is recommended to ensure:

1. Smooth Tibet Permit processing.
2. Proper flight reservations.
3. Hotel and local operator blocking.
4. Sufficient time for physical preparation and medical consultation.

This Yatra requires advance documentation and government approvals. Late entries may not be possible once the permit process begins.

Booking Amount & Payment Policy

1. **25%** of the selected package amount is required at the time of booking to reserve the seat.
2. **50%** payment must be paid after receiving booking confirmation and itinerary / service confirmation
3. Remaining **25%** balance payment must be paid before Yatra departure as per the company payment schedule.
4. For last-minute bookings, air tickets, special category bookings, permit-sensitive bookings or peak season bookings, **100%** payment may be required in advance.
5. Booking amount and all payments will be accepted only in the official company bank account or authorized company payment mode.
6. Do not transfer any amount to any personal account of any staff member, manager, driver, guide or unknown person.
7. Final booking will be considered confirmed only after receipt of payment, required documents and written confirmation from Yattralay.

Cancellation Request Process

1. Cancellation must be given in writing through WhatsApp or Email.
2. Verbal cancellation by phone call will not be accepted.
3. Booking Amount is strictly non-refundable in cash or bank refund.
4. Against a cancelled booking, the Booking Amount will be issued as a Credit Note.
5. Credit Note validity: 2 years from the original Booking Date.
6. Credit Note can be redeemed against another Yattralay booking, subject to seat availability, applicable package price and prevailing terms of that booking.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellation by Participant

1. After booking confirmation: 10% of total Yatra cost will be charged.
2. 60 to 45 days before departure: 50% of total Yatra cost will be charged.
3. 45 to 30 days before departure: 75% of total Yatra cost will be charged.
4. Less than 30 days before departure: 100% non-refundable.
5. After China Group Visa submission: No refund will be possible.
6. Credit Note applies only to the Booking Amount portion, as per company policy.
7. No refund will be applicable for unused services, missed services, personal withdrawal, delayed joining or early exit from the Yatra.

Cancellation Due to Visa Rejection

If China Group Visa is officially rejected in a rare case, refundable components will be returned after deducting actual expenses already incurred for flights, hotels, permits, operator arrangements, documentation and service processing.

Cancellation Due to Weather / Natural / Operational Conditions

No refund will be applicable for delay, route change, additional waiting or operational adjustment caused by:

1. Weather conditions.
2. Flight delay or cancellation.
3. Landslides, road blockage or natural disturbance.
4. Border closure or immigration delay.
5. Government regulations or local authority decisions.

6. Health, acclimatization or safety-related group decisions.

7. Force majeure situations beyond company control.

However, full practical support will be provided to complete the Yatra safely, as per ground reality and official permissions.

Organizer's Right

The Organizer reserves the right to modify the itinerary sequence, travel route, hotel, transport, meal timing or program flow for safety, weather, health, operational or local authority reasons, without compromising the spiritual objective of the Yatra.

MEDICAL FITNESS & SELF-RESPONSIBILITY DECLARATION

Kailash Mansarovar Yatra involves high-altitude travel up to approximately 5,630 meters at Dolma La Pass. The journey includes long drives, changing weather, basic facilities in remote regions and physically demanding trekking conditions during Kailash Parikrama.

Every participant must:

1. Be physically and mentally fit for high-altitude pilgrimage travel.
2. Consult a registered medical practitioner before booking and before departure.
3. Disclose any history of heart disease, high blood pressure, asthma, diabetes, respiratory disorder, major surgery, neurological issue, kidney problem or any serious health condition.
4. Share current medication details with the Organizer / Tour Manager before departure.
5. Understand that medical facilities in the Tibet region and during Parikrama are limited.
6. Participants above 65 years are strongly advised to obtain written medical clearance before booking.

Mandatory Requirements

1. Travel & Rescue Insurance covering high-altitude travel, medical emergency and evacuation is mandatory.
2. Each Yatri must carry sufficient personal medicines for the entire journey, plus additional reserve stock.
